

Want to raise some funds for your school group, church or cultural club?

Then enter the Sustainability Trust's 2010 Porirua Festival Waste Minimisation Challenge !!

The Deal:

Once again, The Sustainability Trust and Porirua City Council are working together with the organisers of Festival of the Elements and Creekfest to help them reduce their waste making these great events zero waste. But we need your help!!

We are setting up recycling and composting bins at both festivals and we need enthusiastic pairs of helpers to make sure people are putting their waste in the right bin.

At each festival, we have a morning and an afternoon shift and we need four pairs of helpers for each shift. Interested groups can apply to work just one shift at one festival, both shifts at one festival, or if they are really keen- both shifts at both festivals! Groups can also enter more than one pair of helpers, it will be first in first served.

For working one shift, each group of two helpers will receive \$152 dollars for their charity, if your pair chooses to work both shifts they will receive \$304!

The Challenge:

During the festivals, the Zero Waste team will be watching the helpers and the pair that is doing the best job will win an extra \$100 for their charity! There is one prize for the morning shift at each festival, and another for the afternoon shift.

This challenge will stand for both events, so even if your team doesn't win at The Festival of the Elements, they will get a second chance at Creekfest!

How to enter the challenge:

To get involved, have a look at the festival dates and times below and work out how many pairs you would like to enter, which shifts they are available for, and whether they would like to help at just one, or both of the festivals.
